
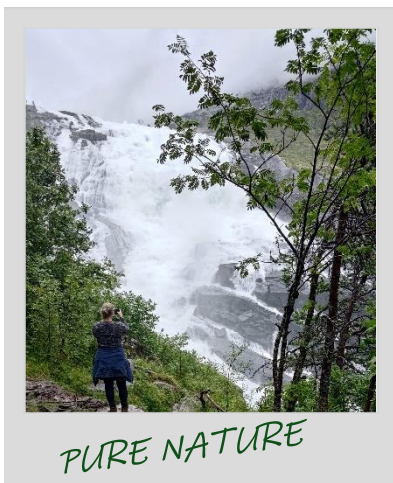




**Welcome to**
